

ORDINANCE NO. 1564

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY,
KANSAS, CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 9-112, COURT COSTS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY,
KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. Chapter IX, Article 1, Section 9-112, Court Costs of the Code of the City of Colby, Kansas, 2007 and Ordinance No. 1273 are repealed.

SECTION 2. Chapter IX, Article 1, Section 9-112, Court Costs of the Code of the City of Colby, Kansas is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) That pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 8 of the City of Colby, Kansas, court costs in the Municipal Court of the City of Colby, Kansas are hereby established and shall be assessed at the Court of the City of Colby, Kansas are hereby established and shall be assessed at the rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per case, except for violations of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities as amended from time to time, which shall be assessed at the rate of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per case; provided, however, if more than one complaint is filed against one person arising out of the same incident, only one (1) court cost shall be assessed.
- (b) All court costs collected by the Municipal Court or the Clerk of the Court shall be apportioned and distributed as follows:
 - (1) To the State Treasurer such amount as may be required by state law or order of the Kansas Supreme Court.
 - (2) The remaining balance shall be placed into the general fund of the City of Colby.
- (c) The Municipal Court may, from time to time, impose and assess additional costs to pay future assessments required by state law or the Kansas Supreme Court. Assessment of additional costs to the City of Colby, Kansas shall require approval of the Governing Body.
- (d) The assessment of costs required by this Ordinance shall be implemented by the Municipal Court and apply to all Municipal Court cases filed on and after the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after publication in the official city newspaper.
