

RESOLUTION NO. 1166

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING A POLICY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS AND GUIDELINES FOR UNDERTAKING AND FINANCING OF A CERTAIN COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PROJECT THEREIN;

WHEREAS, governing body of the city of Colby Kansas adopts the Community Improvement District Development Policy as guidelines for the development of Community Improvement Districts (“Community Improvement Districts”) within the city limits of the City of Colby, Kansas, to undertake construct any “project,” which means (1) Any project within the district to acquire, improve, construct, demolish, remove, renovate, reconstruct, rehabilitate, maintain, restore, replace, renew, repair, install, relocate, furnish, equip or extend projects within the district, to support business activity and economic development, including, but not limited to, the promotion of business activity, development and retention and the recruitment of developers and business; within the district; and

WHEREAS, includes guidelines as to the costs of such Community Improvement Projects, to impose a community improvement district sales tax on the selling of tangible personal property at retail or rendering or furnishing services within Community Improvement Districts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOBY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Effective Date- This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the governing body.
